# **Confession of Sins**

M: God, through Moses, commanded his people, "The man or woman who sins against his neighbor, betrays the Lord and will have to answer for it. He should confess his sin."

Lord Jesus, I long to be cleansed and made whole; Have pardon and mercy on my ill soul. By faith, for my cleansing, I see your blood flow, Now wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.

For I know my transgressions, and my sin is always before me. Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight. Cleanse me with hyssop, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow. Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones you have crushed rejoice. Hide your face from my sins and blot out my iniquity. Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me!
- M: The Lord is merciful and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love. He gives us this great comfort: "As far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us. As a father has compassion for his children, so the Lord has compassion for those who fear him." The blood of His Son, Jesus Christ cleanses us from all sin. Therefore, as a called servant of Christ, and by his authority, I forgive you of all your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.



#### Second Lesson: Galatians 4:4-7

<sup>4</sup>But when the set time had fully come, God sent his Son to be born of a woman, so that he would be born under the law, <sup>5</sup>in order to redeem those under the law, so that we would be adopted as sons. <sup>6</sup>And because you are sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts to shout, "*Abba*, Father!" <sup>7</sup>So you are no longer a slave, but a son. And if you are a son, then you are also an heir of God through Christ. Hymn: #41 "Let All Together Praise our God"

#### Sermon: Matthew 2:13-15, 19-23

<sup>13</sup>After the Wise Men were gone, an angel of the Lord suddenly appeared to Joseph in a dream. He said, "Get up, take the child and his mother, and flee to Egypt. Stay there until I tell you, because Herod will search for the child in order to kill him."

<sup>14</sup>Joseph got up, took the child and his mother during the night, and left for Egypt. <sup>15</sup>He stayed there until the death of Herod. This happened to fulfill what was spoken by the Lord through the prophet: "Out of Egypt I called my son."

<sup>19</sup>After Herod died, an angel of the Lord suddenly appeared in a dream to Joseph in Egypt. The angel said, <sup>20</sup>"Get up, take the child and his mother, and go to the land of Israel, for those who were trying to kill the child are dead." <sup>21</sup>Joseph got up, took the child and his mother, and went to the land of Israel. <sup>22</sup>But when he heard that Archelaus, Herod's son, had succeeded his father as ruler in Judea, he was afraid to go there. Since he had been warned in a dream, he went to the region of Galilee. <sup>23</sup>When he arrived there, he settled in a city called Nazareth. So what was spoken through the prophets was fulfilled: "He will be called a Nazarene."


