Listen, so that you may continue to live.


Yes, I will make an everlasting covenant with you, the faithful mercies promised to David.

GOSPEL LESSON: Matthew 14:13-21

¹³When Jesus heard this, he withdrew from there in a boat to a deserted place to be alone. When the crowds heard this, they followed him on foot from the towns.

¹⁴When Jesus got out of the boat, he saw a large crowd. He had compassion on them and healed their sick. ¹⁵When evening came, his disciples came to him and said, "This is a deserted place and the hour is already late. Send the crowds away, so that they can go into the villages and buy food for themselves."

¹⁶But Jesus said to them, "They do not need to go away. You

give them something to eat."

17 They told him, "We have here only five loaves and two fish." 18 Bring them here to me," he replied. 19 Then he instructed the people to sit down on the grass. The disciples gave the food to the people. 20 They all ate and were filled. SERMON: Romans 8:35-39

³⁵What will separate us from the love of Christ? Will trouble or distress or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? ³⁶Just as it is written:

For your sake we are being put to death all day long.

We are considered as sheep to be slaughtered.

³⁷No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.

³⁸For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor rulers, neither things present nor things to come, nor powerful forces, ³⁹neither height nor depth, nor anything else in creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Nicene Creed
