#### **CONFESSION OF SINS**




### FIRST LESSON: Acts 14:8-18

<sup>8</sup>In Lystra there was a man who was sitting down because he had no strength in his feet. He had never walked because he was lame from birth. <sup>9</sup>When he was listening to Paul as he was speaking, Paul looked at him closely and saw that he had faith to be healed. <sup>10</sup>Paul said in a loud voice, "Stand up on your feet!" And the man jumped up and began to walk.

<sup>11</sup>When the crowds saw what Paul had done, they raised their voices, saying in the Lycaonian language, "The gods have come down to us in human form." <sup>12</sup>Barnabas they called Zeus, and Paul they called Hermes, because he was the main speaker. <sup>13</sup>The priest of Zeus, whose temple was just outside the city, brought bulls and garlands to the city gates, because he wanted to offer sacrifices

along with the crowds.

14But when the apostles Paul and Barnabas heard about this, they tore their clothes and rushed into the crowd, shouting, 15"Men, why are you doing these things? We too are men with the same nature as you. We are preaching the good news to you so that you turn from these worthless things to the living God, who made the heaven, the earth, the sea, and everything in them. 16 In past generations he allowed all the nations to go their own ways. 17 Yet he did not leave himself without testimony of the good he does. He gives you rain from heaven and crops in their seasons. He fills you with food and fills your hearts with gladness." 18 Even though they said these things, they had a hard time stopping the crowds from sacrificing to them.

# SECOND LESSON: Revelation 21:10-14, 22, 23

<sup>10</sup>He carried me away in spirit to a great and high mountain, and he showed me the Holy City, Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God. <sup>11</sup>It has the glory of God. Its radiance is similar to a very precious stone, like crystal-clear jasper.

<sup>12</sup>It has a large, high wall. It has twelve gates. Twelve angels are at the gates, and twelve names are engraved on the gates, the names of the twelve tribes of the sons of Israel. <sup>13</sup>Three gates are on the east, three on the north, three on the south, and three on the west. <sup>14</sup>The city's wall also has twelve foundations, and on them are the twelve names of the Lamb's twelve apostles.

<sup>22</sup>I did not see a temple in the city, because the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple. <sup>23</sup>The city does not need the sun or the moon to shine on it, because the glory of God has given it light, and the Lamb is its lamp.




