



### FIRST LESSON: Galatians 3:23-29

<sup>23</sup>But before this faith came, we were held in custody under the law, imprisoned until the coming faith was revealed. <sup>24</sup>So the law was our chaperone until Christ, so that we might be justified by faith. <sup>25</sup>But now that this faith has come, we are no longer under a chaperone.

<sup>26</sup>In fact, you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus.
<sup>27</sup>Indeed, as many of you as were baptized into Christ have been clothed with Christ. <sup>28</sup>There is not Jew or Greek, slave or free, male or female, for you are all one and the same in Christ Jesus.
<sup>29</sup>And if you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's descendants and heirs according to the promise.

#### **GOSPEL LESSON: Luke 9:18-24**

<sup>18</sup>One time when Jesus was praying alone and the disciples were with him, he asked them, "Who do the crowds say that I am?"

<sup>19</sup>They answered, "'John the Baptist,' but others say, 'Elijah,' and others say, 'one of the ancient prophets come back to life.'"

<sup>20</sup>He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?"

And Peter answered, "The Christ of God."

<sup>21</sup>He gave them a strict command not to tell this to anyone. <sup>22</sup>He said, "The Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders, chief priests, and experts in the law. He must be killed and be raised on the third day."

<sup>23</sup>Jesus said to all of them, "If anyone wants to come after me, let him deny himself, take up his cross daily, and follow me. <sup>24</sup>For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will save it.

#### SERMON: Genesis 39:6-12, 16-23

Joseph was well built and handsome. <sup>7</sup>Sometime after all this, his master's wife had her eye on Joseph, and she said, "Come, lie down with me." <sup>8</sup>But he refused and said to his master's wife, "Look, my master does not concern himself with anything that has been entrusted to me in the house. He has put me in charge of every-thing that he has. <sup>9</sup>He has no one in this house greater than I am, and he has not withheld anything from me except you, because you are his wife. How then could I do such a great evil and sin against God?"

<sup>10</sup>She kept speaking to Joseph day after day, but he would not listen to her. He would not lie down beside her or even be with her. <sup>11</sup>But one day when he went into the house to do his work, none of the men of the household were there inside the house. <sup>12</sup>She caught him by his garment and said, "Come, lie down with me!" He left behind his garment in her hand and ran outside.

<sup>16</sup>She kept his garment beside her until his master came home. <sup>17</sup>This is what she told him: "The Hebrew servant, whom you have brought to us, came to me to put me to shame and said to me, 'Let me lie down with you.' <sup>18</sup>And look, when I screamed and cried out, he left behind his garment with me and ran outside."

<sup>19</sup>As soon as his master heard the words that his wife spoke to him, saying, "This is what your servant did to me," he became very angry. <sup>20</sup>Joseph's master took him and put him into the prison where the king's prisoners were confined, so Joseph was kept in prison there.

<sup>21</sup>But the LORD was with Joseph. He showed mercy to him and gave him favor in the sight of the warden of the prison. <sup>22</sup>The warden of the prison made Joseph responsible for all the prisoners who were in the prison. Joseph was responsible for whatever they did there. <sup>23</sup>The warden of the prison did not pay attention to anything that was under his authority, because the LORD was with Joseph, and the LORD made everything that he did succeed.
